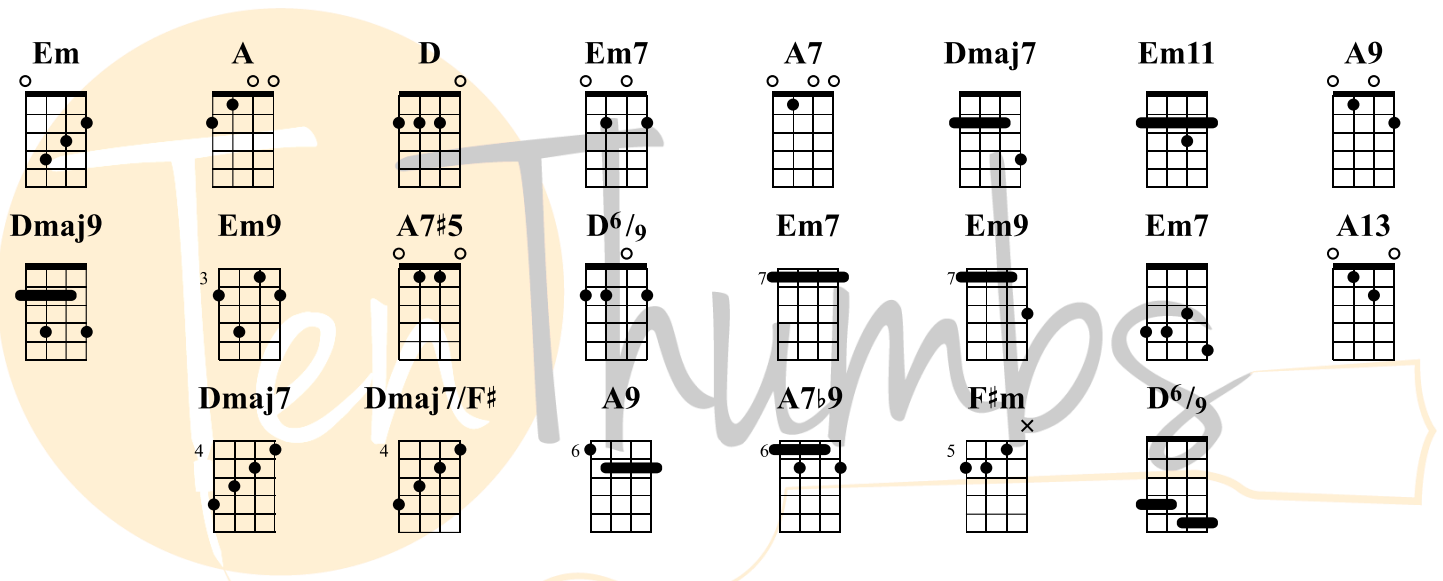

Chord Shapes:



Take your time with those chord shapes, there are some really cool ones!

Step 1, use a key chart to pick a key and then identify the ii chord, V chord and I chord

Key Chord Chart

Major Key	I	II	III	IV	V	VI	VII
A	A	Bm	C#m	D	E	F#m	G#dim
B	B	C#m	D#m	E	F#	G#m	A#dim
C	C	Dm	Em	F	G	Am	Bdim
D	D	Em	F#m	G	A	Bm	C#dim
E	E	F#m	G#m	A	B	C#m	D#dim
F	F	Gm	Am	Bb	C	Dm	Edim
G	G	Am	Bm	C	D	Em	F#dim

In the key of D they are Em, A and D

We are going to start with a diatonic progression

Em A D

Now we are going to add the 7 extensions

Em7 A7 Dmaj7

Now we will extend it a little further with some different chords, m11, 9 and maj9 chords

Em11 A9 Dmaj9

Here is another progression if you can play that crazy em9 chord!

Em9 A7#5 D6/9

Now we are going to use the chords as passing chords and the D scale, too

Em7 Em9 Em7 Em7 A7 A13 A7#5 Dmaj7 Dmaj7
