

Vampire Flesh



Today, I will introduce how to paint the pale skin of vampire. First, priming the entire model with black.

If the base color is black, you can get a heavy color even if you paint your skin brightly. I sprayed AK 3rd Gen Black with an air brush, but it's okay just using a black spray primer.

After that, paint all skin part with GW Base Rakarth Flesh.



It's time to create light and shade. I diluted GW Base Rakarth Flesh + Vallejo Nocturna Burned Flesh (1:1) like a shade and painted it on deep wrinkles. After that, glaze the border of the two color with same mix.

When you paint pale skin, the feeling varies greatly depending on what color you put in the shadow. If you use purple or blue, it will feel more inhumane, and if you use red, it will feel more humane. I intentionally used a moderate ocher color.



If the dark part is over, it's time to paint brightly. I set the main light source to the upper left. Referring to the picture above, you can see how I applied the highlight. I used AK 3rd Gen Deck Tan to paint the light-receiving areas. Paint Deck Tan thinly several times until the color comes out clearly.



Now dilute GW Base Rakarth Plesh + AK 3rd Gen Deck Tan (1:1) and glaze the boundary between the two colors.

At the same time, I painted my eyes and mouth with AK 3rd Gen Burnt Red. I used red because I wanted to paint evil red eyes, but it's okay to use black as usual if you want.



Paint only the areas that receive the most light with AK 3rd Gen Deck Tan + AK 3rd Gen White Grey (1:1). After that, dilute the same color and glaze the borders couple times. You can see that the forehead, cheekbones, bones on the back of the hand, and the upper finger are a little brighter.

At the same time, I painted the inside of red with AK 3rd Gen White Grey to express the white of eyes and teeth. If you prefer GW styles vampire eyes, you can stop here.



If you painted apple of the eyes with Kimera Red, face is done!

This recipe is can be applied to other models like Idoneth Deepkin in Age of Sigmar.
