Hello, everybody. This is your humble GM, Erika Ishi, and today I'm going to bring you a little story from the farmyard. We're going to be using the system Roll for Shoes, which is quite simple, but I have added a couple of twists and turns in there.

Erika Ishii

There are about seven rules. Number one, you say what you do and you roll a number of D6s determined by the level of relevant skill that you have. And at the start, you have only one skill, "Do anything: 1". If the sum of your roll is higher than the opposing roll, the thing that you wanted to happen happens. If you roll all sixes, you get a new skill specific to the action, one level higher than the one you used. So say you say, I would like to roll to put on my shoes, and you roll 1D6 and say, you ace it. You get a six, you put on your shoes. And you also get to roll two dice for tying shoelaces.

Erika Ishii

For every roll that you fail, you get one experience point. Experience Points can normally be used to change a die into a six for advancement purposes only. So you can learn a new skill, but not make it a success. However, the little twist in the rules is that experience points can also be saved up and used to flash back to a prior scene and change something. Two XP flashes back a brief time ago. Oh, but I actually picked his pocket five minutes ago. Five Experience Points flashes you back to before the events that you have heard. So I picked his pocket back before we started the job.

Erika Ishii

Eight Experience Points flashes you back to the beginning and changes the whole nature of the game. But what you didn't realize all along that we had this plot, ha ha! And others can help their fellow players by adding plus one pip for each skill level that is helping. For instance, if Brennan needs help tying his shoes, and Aabria has +2 to tying shoes, Brennan will roll the D6 with plus two, at the end.

Lou Wilson

We're all in the room, by the way, just in case you're wondering.

Erika Ishii

Yeah, we're here.

Aabria Iyengar

They're not here.

Erika Ishii

But you don't have any questions about this system?

Lou Wilson

No, I understand it completely. And that Brennan needs help tying his shoes.

Aabria Iyengar

Well, he gets confused where the bunny rabbit goes.

Brennan Lee Mulligan

Yeah, the bunny rabbit thing just makes me feel like, oh, this is exciting. There's a rabbit, but it's like, here's the rabbit, here's the tree. And you're like, well, they look identical.

Erika Ishii

That's the problem, is that the bunny ears, right. But the tree is part of the bunny. The tree that has the hole is part of the bunny.

Aabria Iyengar

Yes.

Erika Ishii

All right.

Aabria Iyengar

I don't know how this is difficult to people.

Erika Ishii

All right, maybe I don't understand animals, and this was the wrong thing to pick for a game.

Aabria Iyengar

I'm going to play a bunny that's also a tree. And a hole? You gotta edit this out. He's not gonna.

Erika Ishii

[Slowly, while typing] I just... add this all in... last minute.

Brennan Lee Mulligan

Bunny ears, bunny ears playing by a tree, crisscrossed the tree, trying to catch me. Bunny ears, bunny ears, jumped into the hole, popped out the other side, beautiful and bold. Now, this website wants me to believe that this is how people were taught this.

Aabria Iyengar

I've never heard that before. Have people heard that before?

Erika Ishii

[Yelling] No. That's a much more difficult way to tie your shoes.

Lou Wilson

That's only in the countryside where people are like "You need a song to tie your shoes." Anyway, I'm sorry for derailing us. It was funny to be talking about us, and we're just all sitting here going, "Mhm, Brennan needs help tying his shoes, and Aabria helps, and he gets two pips."

Erika Ishii Lou.
Lou Wilson It's like six minutes.
Erika Ishii Really?
Brennan Lee Mulligan SIX MINUTES?
Lou Wilson If I'm in the bathroom for more than six minutes.
Aabria Iyengar [Yelling] Then why didn't you go in for Erica?
Lou Wilson I wanted to! But I understand that mine is pretty tight. I like to do it and ride. And my big thing is it's also socially. So it's like, if there is a person in my house, well, I won't go fucking luxuriate in my fucking bathroom, if there are people in my house. I'm like, get this shit out of me. I have to go.
Brennan Lee Mulligan Lou is throwing an absolute rager. I knock on the bathroom like, I can't tell if anyone's in here. And I open and you're taking a full bath.
Lou Wilson Full bath.
Brennan Lee Mulligan Full bath.
Lou Wilson Two more minutes. Two more fucking minutes.

Erika Ishii

Well we all did shower together, so ya know.

Brennan Lee Mulligan

I know three quarters of the podcast did shower together.

Aabria Iyengar

It is so fucked up I didn't get to go to that.

Brennan Lee Mulligan

Literally, the only reason you were not in that shower with us Aabria, is that you lived closer to the venue.

Erika Ishii

Yep.

Lou Wilson

You fool. You fool.

Aabria Iyengar

That's fucked up.

Erika Ishii

Yeah. Brennan what's your time track, then?

Brennan Lee Mulligan

No amount of time. Infinite. Infinite time. When you go to the bathroom when you go to the bathroom, I assume you know what you're doing. And if I never hear from you again, I'm going to weep bitter tears and say goodbye and then put big red tape over that door and say, "This isn't a bathroom anymore. This is a mausoleum. Aabria Iyengar

Erika Ishii

Lou Wilson

Aabria Iyengar

Lou Wilson

Okay. Got it.

Erika Ishii

Yeah. Stalling before I had to run a game, which, ya know.

Lou Wilson

They did stick their head out the door and go, do we have to leave yet? We had all been standing outside for about 15 minutes.

Aabria Iyengar Yes. Truly.

Lou Wilson

I had loaded the car. The family van was packed.

Brennan Lee Mulligan

This is going to be so much fun. I can't wait. You're gonna do a great job!

Erika Ishii

Well, here we go. Without further stalling-

Lou Wilson

Are you sure we got any more questions? Do we need to check in? Brennan, do you have any more public statements?

Brennan Lee Mulligan

If I... Here's another thing, I think. If you're in a bathroom and someone is brushing their teeth, you should have court vision of when they need to spit. Okay. And that's the mark of a good partnership, Izzy and I, great court awareness. Great court awareness.

[Everyone laughs] Lou Wilson And I swallow. Brennan Lee Mulligan [In an old lady voice] And I love to swallow. Gulp gulp! Erika Ishii Here we go.
