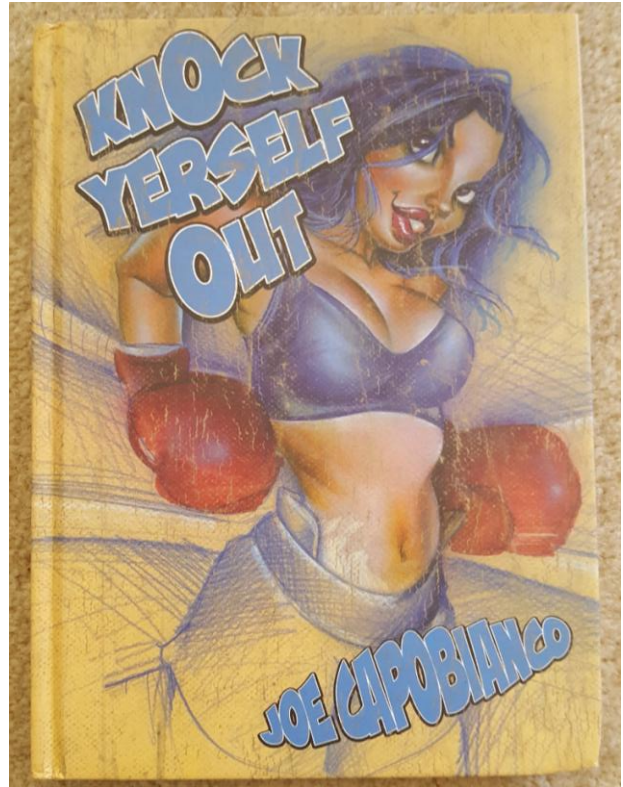

Mr. Capobianco's art style is a playful and cartoony look. Facial features and gendered body dimensions are exaggerated.

The subjects of all drawings in the book are women. The images are drawn either as pencil sketches (graphite or color), pencils & inks, or fully colored in a variety of methods.

A number of female metahumans are represented in the works presented. Serpentine, angelic, demonic, composite, mer, nymph, air, vampiric, statue (specifically Lady Liberty), undead, and alien all have full page pieces, some as two-

page spreads. Most metas are present in more than one artwork.

This is in addition to human women in various outfits, from pirate to maid.

A number of images include topless nudity. Although some of the subjects are also bottomless, this is not presented in a crass manner, nor is there penetration of any kind.

The book is overall nicely presented, and with the high number of metahuman representations this is greatly recommended as something that TF collectors should be on the lookout for.
